



1. – Network Length and Openings

The toll motorway network reaches a total of **9 049.6** kilometers of toll motorway in service as from 31.12.2014.

2. - Investments^()**

The amount of investments financed in 2014 by all French tolled companies was 1.3 **billion** euros^(*).

3. – Revenues^()**

The turnover in 2014, without VAT, totaled **9.24** billion €.

4. Staff

There are 14 067 permanent staff working on the network.

5. – Traffic

87.3 billion kilometers have been driven on the network by end of 2014.

Traffic over the stable network is as follows compared to 2011 : + 2.0 % traffic increase for the whole vehicles (trucks + cars)

6 – toll

All means of payments are accepted on the toll plaza, below a distribution according to each means. Nationwide ETC interoperability is deployed in France (TIS VL). ETC for truck has been implemented since 2007 to be compliant with the European Electronic Toll service. ETC for light vehicle (Liber-t) has been deployed since 2000. There are now 5.8 millions subscribers.

7 - Safety

- **Safety Shows Constant Progress on Concession Motorway**

Safety figures for 2014 are characterized by a decrease in the number of deaths (142 deaths versus 169 in 2013).

Over the last 10 years, the number of people killed on the network has been cut in half, and over the last 30 years, the risk of being killed has been cut in seven if we take into account the increase in traffic.

Between 2000 and 2014, the number of people killed on the roads has been divided by 3 approximately. It is estimated that 2/3 of such a decrease result from a drop in speed limit violations following the implementation of the automated speed control/fines program, the remaining 1/3 resulting from the initiatives taken by roadway companies.

The rate of motorists driving at speeds greater than 130 km/hr is 27 % and the rate of vehicles driving at speed over than 150km/hr remains stable with 2% in 2014.

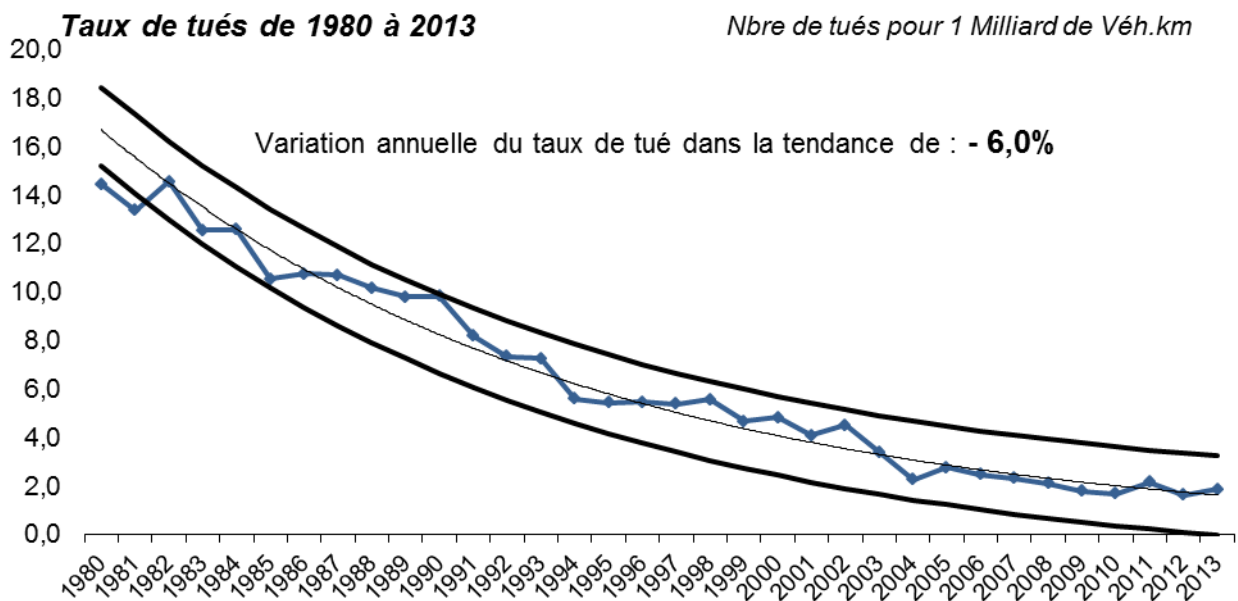

Definition :

- (1) Serious Injured people (SI)BH) : casualties having spend more than 24 hours in Hospital
- (2) Light injured people (LI) : No hospitalisation
- (3) Death :casualty who died on the accident site or within 30 days following the occurrence of the accident



Motorway companies have continued their driver-targeted awareness campaigns promoting the risks associated with sleepiness at the wheel, which remains the leading cause of accidents on the network in general.

Number of accidents caused by wrong way driving has increased. In 2014, French toll operators have made a specific focus with an awareness campaign with a common message developed nationwide on the 107.7 dedicated motorway radio.
