



ASECAP, IBTTA release a "Joint Tolling Declaration"

ASECAP DECLARATION | IBTTA

IBTTA has released a "Joint Declaration on Tolling" with the European tollers' association ACECAP at their meeting in Dubrovnik Croatia. It touts six advantages of tolls over taxes for roads:

1. "Scarcity" of tax revenues



- 2. More sustainable as fuel revenues are declining: "Tolling embraces the user pays principle much more effectively than a tax on fuel:"
- 3. To the extent roads are tolled tax revenues can go to support other important government needs education, social security, defense etc
- 4. Tolls are fairest and the best way to fund roads and can't be gamed by across-border shifting of taxes
- 5. Manage traffic in dense urban areas with variable rates
- 6. By enabling good roads to be built faster and better they enhance economic growth

Signatories are or the Europeans ASECAP president Klaus Schierhackl, and for the Americans IBTTA president Robert Horr.

A Preamble says: "ASECAP and IBTTA think that a wider application of tolling policies, based on the user pays principle, will be highly beneficial for governments - especially those that face severe economic pressure and may not have enough funds either to support new infrastructure or improve existing ones – and the users, who can immediately see the benefits they receive for the fees they pay on the road infrastructure they use."
