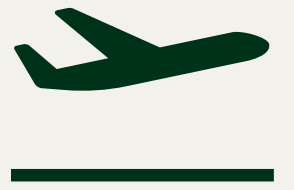

= **voluntary** carbon emissions management **certification** program for **airports**.

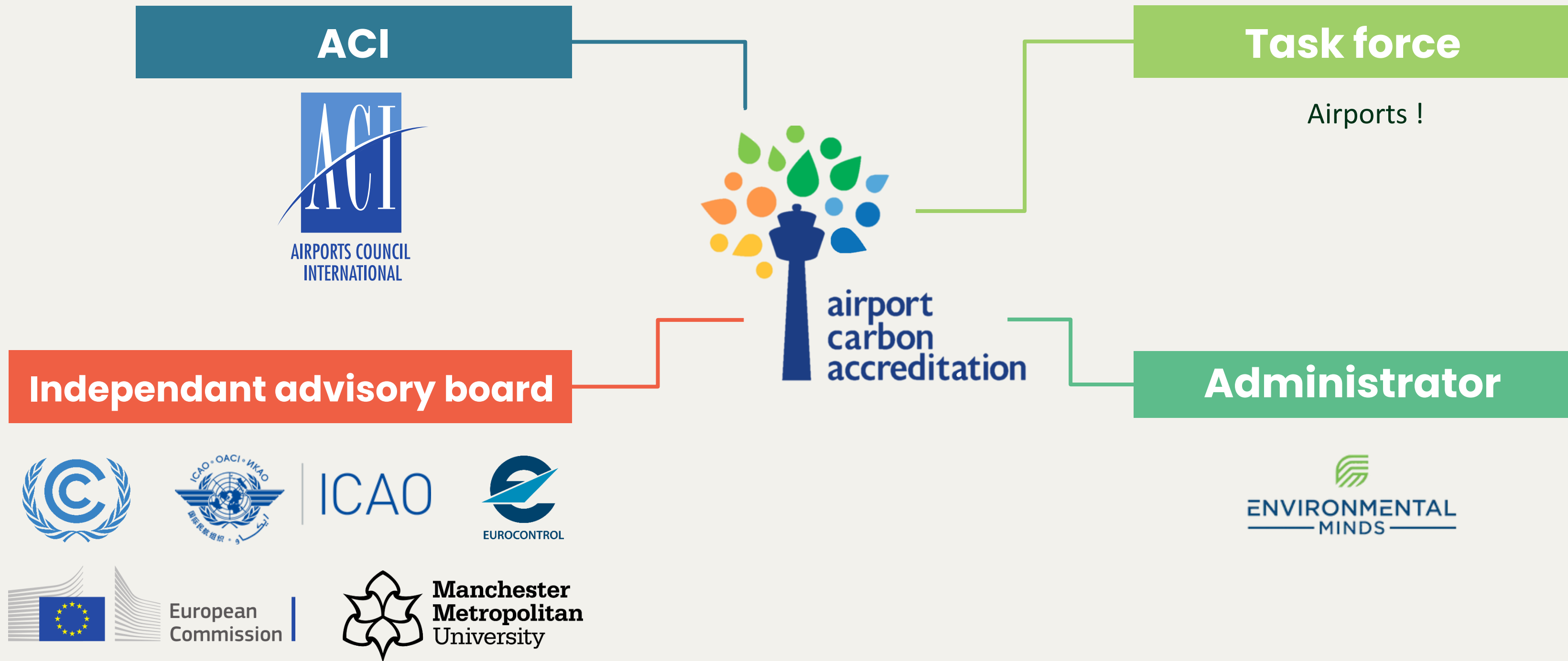
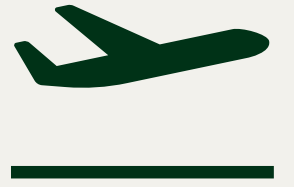
- **7 levels** of certification

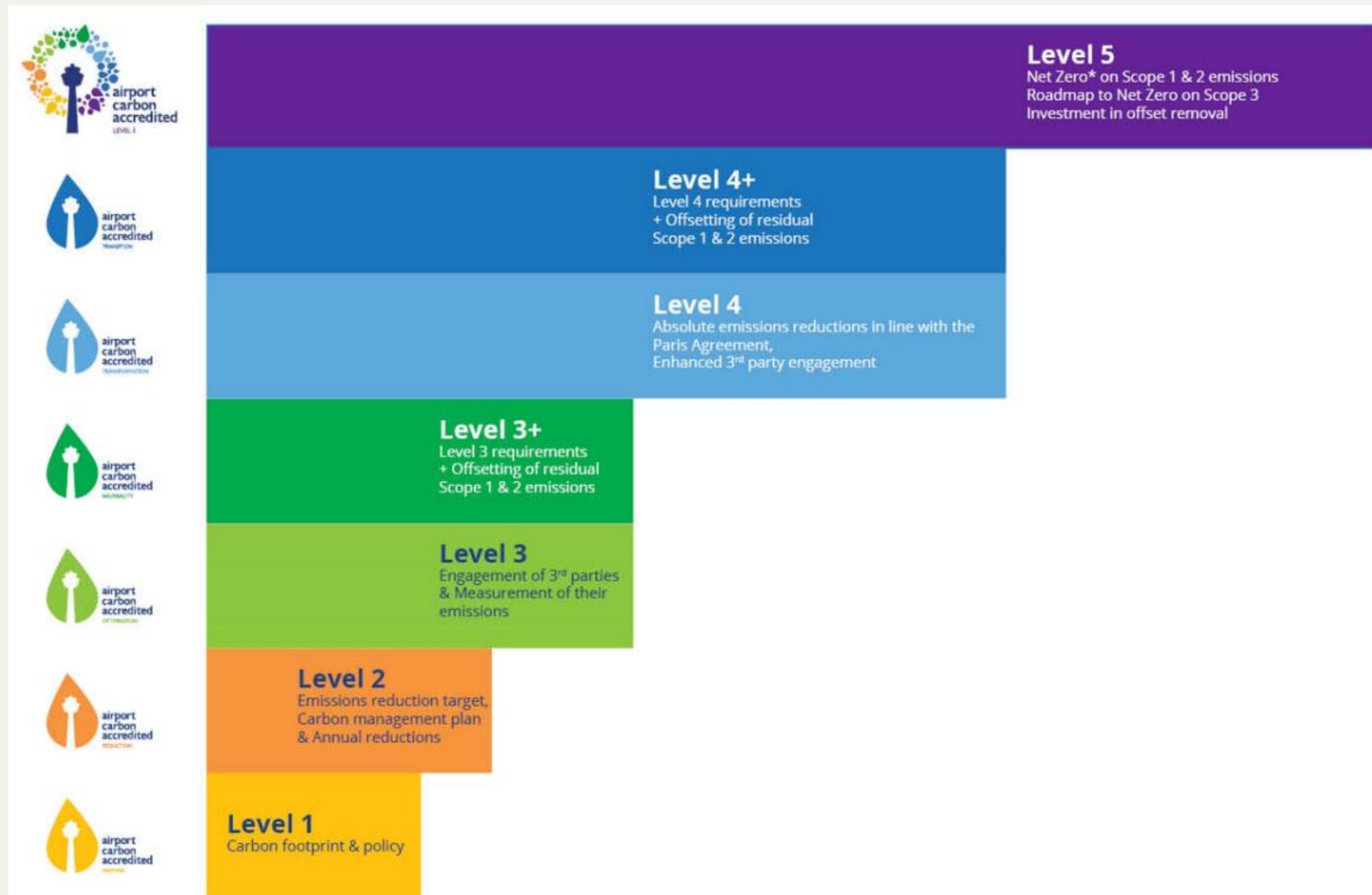
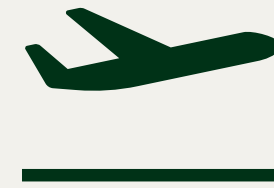

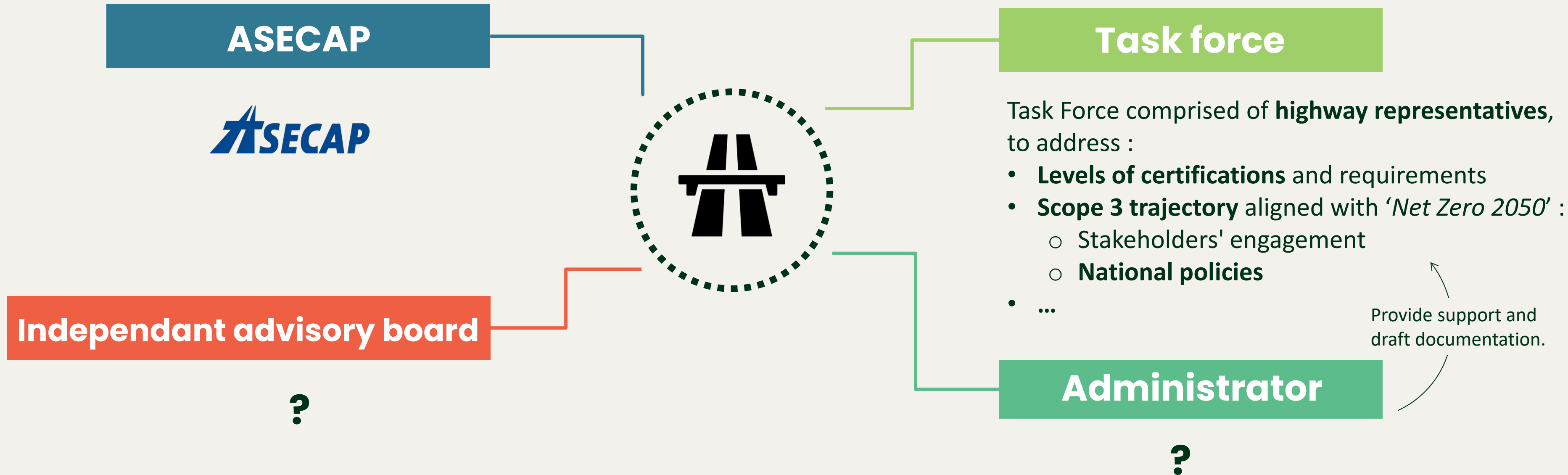
