Is vision zero fatality a realistic target with all the challenges raising?

- Climate change disturbances with increase of extreme weather, flood, heavy snow, fire just to mention few consequences
- Motorway agents, Police, rescue services intervene in traffic to guarantee the safety. However, despite their professionalism, the inattention, distraction of motorists on the motorway is at the origin of many accidents whose consequences are heavy: doors torn off, vans hit, luminous arrows and traffic cones hit and even more serious when a patrol or rescue staff is hurt.

With those challenges into perspective, ASECAP and its members consider Road Safety as the key mission guiding their work and activities to keep ensuring that well maintain motorways are the safest roads in Europe with a vision to reach ZERO accidents and fatalities both for their customers as well as for their staff patrollers.

What actions, what communication can be made?

ASECAP road safety conference will be the opportunity to actively discuss what actions can be carried out to limit the very harsh consequences of road accidents and to reach the ambitious goals of UN and EC to eradicate road fatalities.


